ALL: **on a colt, the foal of a donkey.**

### We share the Peace

ONE: Jesus said: If any intent on standing in God's presence  
remembers on their way that things are not right between them and another,  
first let them go and make peace;  
then, and only then, may they offer themselves to God.

ALL: **Let us strive to live at peace;  
let us forgive one another.  
Let us exchange words of peace and welcome.**

ONE: The Peace of Christ be with you.

ALL: **And also with you.**

like bread we break for sharing;  
look people warmly in the eye:  
our life is meant for caring.

As at communion, shape your hands  
into a waiting cradle;  
the gift of Christ receive, revere,

In the name of the one who came into the world not to condemn
